ENTRY FEES

First entry of a dog in obedience or rally **in each event** - \$30.00.

Additional entry of the same dog **in the same event** - \$25.00. Remember that each rally trial is a separate event.

Rally RAE entry is \$55, RACH entry is \$80 **in the same event**.

Note: If a bitch entered in the Obedience or Rally Classes comes in season after the Trial's closing date, the entry fee, less \$5.00 will be refunded. To be eligible for a refund, a statement from a veterinarian must be presented to the Show Secretary before ½ hour before the start of the first class on the day of the trial. Move ups in obedience or rally will be accepted, but must be presented to the Show Secretary before the first class of that event.

TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of Official AKC entry forms are not acceptable.

NO ENTRY shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

Fees include the \$4.00 AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE AND A RECORDING FEE of \$.50 on the first entry of a dog and a \$4.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, or the \$4.50 AKC Recording Fee on the first entry of a dog in Rally and \$4.50 for each additional rally entry. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes or special attractions.) These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2).

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

Companion Dog Training Club, 3440 Torrey Road, Flint, MI 48507

Approximately 4 miles from downtown Flint, this site is in an industrial park south and west of the city.

To Show Site:

From East or West: Take I-69 to I-75/US-23 South. Go 1.8 miles to exit 116B for Bristol Rd W. Merge onto W Bristol Rd. Go west approximately ½ mile to Torrey Rd – turn right (Mobil Gas Station). Companion Dog Training Club is .2 miles on the left.

From South: Take I-75 to exit 116 Bristol Rd (toward Bishop International Airport). Keep **left** at the fork, follow signs for Bristol Road W and merge onto W Bristol Rd. Go east .3 miles to Torrey Rd. Turn right near the Mobil Gas station. Companion Dog Training Club is .2 miles on the left.

From North: Take I-75 to exit 116B Bristol Rd W. Merge onto W Bristol Rd. Go west approximately ½ mile to Torrey Rd – turn right (Mobil Gas Station). Companion Dog Training Club is .2 miles on the left.

There are no major construction projects planned near the show site but you can check the site: www.michigan.gov/drive for up to date information about roads.

The show site is a beautiful building in an industrial park. The area is well lighted and has a nice amount of grassy area for exercising dogs, however there is a designated potty area. The training center is fully matted and ready for dog events.

(Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, part-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
